IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR UPCOMING ELECTIONS

Petition Filing Governor Murphy's Executive Order providing for the filing of petitions in both traditional paper form and in electronic form, for State, County, Municipal, School Board or Fire Commission offices is no longer in effect with the signing of A-5820 and the issue of Executive Order 244 ending the COVID 19 Public Health Emergency. After July 2, 2021 only traditional paper petitions with all applicable notarized signatures may be submitted as hard copies by mail, courier or personal delivery.

Dear Citizen,

In an effort to assist the public, it is a pleasure to offer you this 2021 Election dates flyer. 2021 is a Gubernatorial Election Year. The right to vote is a key element of our democracy and an important responsibility. Hopefully this flyer will help to assist you by providing information and reminders on critical deadlines and dates that occur throughout the year involving voting and elections.

As your County Clerk, I am responsible for administering an array of election services to the public. The following is an outline of the main electoral responsibilities and duties of the County Clerk which are administered through the County Clerk's Election Office:

1. Filing Officer for partisan nomination petitions for County Offices (Commissioner, Clerk, Sheriff & Surrogate).
2. Filing Officer for Independent (Nomination by Direct Petition) candidates running for County, Municipal and School Board offices.
3. Recipient of Vote by Mail Ballot Applications which are reviewed for approval (issuance of Ballot) or rejection (notification sent to applicant).
4. Designs and prints Ballot materials (Vote by Mail Ballots, Emergency/Provisional Ballots, Voting Machine Ballot Faces and Sample Ballots).
5. Publishes the notices of Vote by Mail Ballot availability for all county wide elections.
6. Clerk of the County Board of Canvassers (which is the four member County Board of Elections) which certifies election results.
7. Issues Certificates of Election for County & Municipal Officers after the General Election is certified.

OCTOBER 2021

✓ Monday, October 4 - 29 Day Pre-General Election Campaign Finance Report due.

✓ Tuesday, October 12 - Voter Registration Deadline for Nov General Election.

✓ Friday, October 15 - Continuing Political Action Committee 3rd Quarter Finance Report due.

✓ Friday, October 22 - 11-Day Pre-General Election Campaign Finance Report due.

✓ Tuesday, October 26 - Last day for County Clerk to receive by mail a Vote by Mail application for the Nov General Election.

NOVEMBER 2021

✓ Monday, November 1 - Last day to apply in person for a Vote by Mail Ballot, 3pm deadline.

✓ Tuesday, November 2 - General Election Day, Polls Open 6am - 8pm.

✓ Monday, November 15 - County Board of Canvassers Certifies General Election results.

✓ Friday, November 19 -Deadline to file a Recount Application to a Superior Court Judge.

✓ Monday, November 22 - 20-Day Post General Election Campaign Finance Report due.

COVID-19 Notice for Filing Petitions

With the Governor's signing of Executive Order 244 ending the Public Health Emergency, the provisions previous Executive Orders and recently enacted legislation allowing electronic collection and transmission of petitions have terminated. To be valid, wet ink signatures on petitions must be collected in person and the physical petitions must be filed directly with the accepting office.
